

Winter 2010 Belleview Chess Class

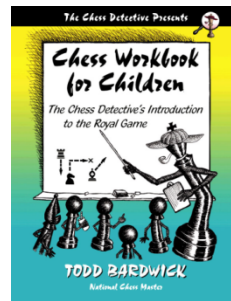
National Chess Master Todd Bardwick will be offering a twelve-week beginner/intermediate chess class at Belleview starting on Thursday, January 7, 2010.
